The 2014 edition welcomes China as guest of honor to celebrate 50th Anniversary of France-China relationships. For this occasion, Helene Bailly gallery, in collaboration with Shangart gallery, dedicates one exclusive space to the Chinese artist Zhang Ding - booth E11. And on the booth B3 : Helene Bailly gallery is pleased to present alongside works by Denis Rouvre, Clemence van Lunen, François Xavier Chanioux, Coco Fronsac...

Katrin Fridriks' new series of "reflected papers" entitled "Skylanders", referring to those legendary heroes and champions in the world of Skylands, "using their magical powers and machinery, to defend their world for next generations, keeping peace and balance".

The "reflected papers" match a double reflection/research: A pictorial research aligned with the process of her series "Awareness" (2011) and its metallic orientation using "gold, silver, copper, steel...". The second line of research focuses on the new media. Manufactured using an high quality film, these so-called reflective papers produce a new & relevant energy of surface. The brightness and the mirror effect of the metallised surface enhance the contrast with the mat paint.

Linking both elements, this particular work plays with light & reflection. Thus, the pictorial answer creates a real sculptural dimension highlighted with reliefs and depth. From her abstract gesture, Katrin Fridriks likes finding facial expression in her paintings; eyes, a mouth, a mask take shape throughout her matter/tint areas, as finding her own super heroes.

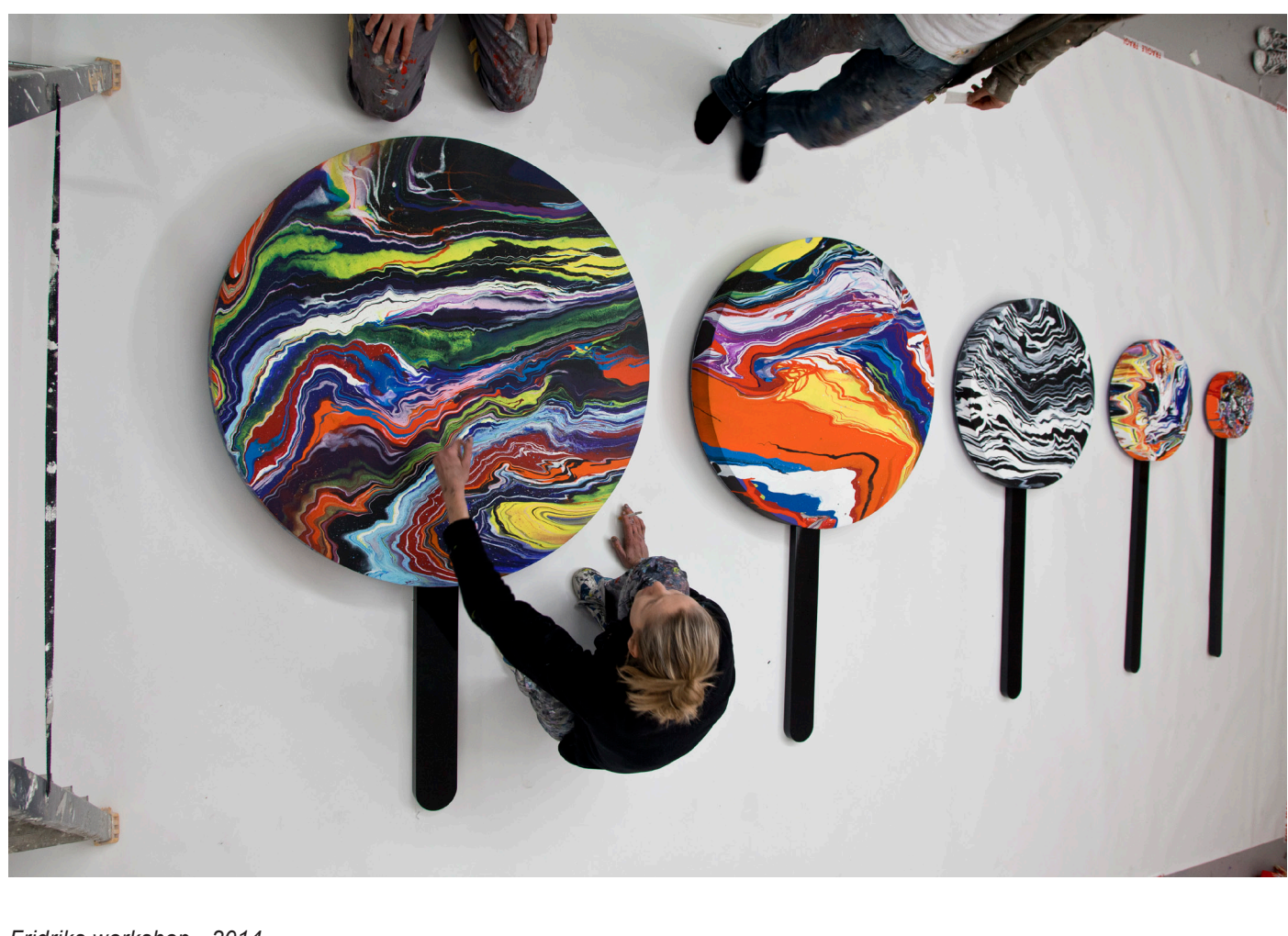
